

What is Remo?

Remo is a virtual lounge that will be available as a place to gather and chat outside the panel and workshop program of SALSA 2021.

Entering the room

When you enter Remo, you will see an overhead view of a room filled with tables as well as small circle icons with initials or photographs of your fellow conference attendees. You will have the option of setting up a profile card linked to your Remo icon with your name, email and any other details you'd like to share with SALSA members, like a business card. The platform enables small group conversations and allows you to move and mingle in virtual space.

Joining a Table

You will be able to recognize a friend or colleague and join them at their table by clicking on an open chair. Clicking on an open chair brings you into a video (or voice-only) meeting with other people at that table. It is similar to a Zoom breakout room. In Remo you continue to see the other tables and have the ability to move yourself to a new table – mingling with your SALSA peers as we have always done during in-person conferences.

Sending Chat Messages

You can also send Chat messages to the entire room, only your table, or directly as a private message.

Private Chat Messages and Private Meetings

Want to have a private conversation with a friend between sessions? Pick a two-person table and others will not be able to join. You might say, "Let's meet at Table 26 during the coffee break." Want to let others drop into your conversation? Join a table with up to 8 seats and your colleagues will be able to join if there is an open seat.
